Palm Sunday, April 13, begins our Holy Week observance. Palm Sunday commemorates Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem.

Sunday we will begin our Holy Week prayer and worship in the Sanctuary at 7:00 pm.

Monday we will share in prayer together in the Sanctuary at 7:00 pm.

As part of our Holy Week observance join in fasting Tuesday, 4:00 pm to Wednesday 4:00 pm. Fasting is often associated with humility, repentance, and seeking God's guidance and strength.

Tuesday spend time in reflection at our Prayer Stations in the Mission Building 7:00 pm - 8:00 pm. **Wednesday** join us for prayer together in the Sanctuary at 7:00 pm.

Maundy Thursday communion worship at 7:00 pm in the Sanctuary as we commemorate Jesus' Last Supper with the disciples.

Good Friday worship at noon in the Sanctuary when we remember the crucifixion of Jesus, his final hours and death at Calvary.
